# The Trip

### 8:00 am

What a beautiful day!

If you have ever climbed at Carderock on a beautiful fall day you know you want to be there early because the best spots fill up very quickly. We were in no such hurry. No one was going to take our spots today!

Most everyone was there by 8:00; it took a little time to get gear organized and the boats blown up, so it worked out perfectly. And thanks so much to Carol for bringing her electric pump! That let us save our muscle power for the rock. :)

We launched directly from Hades Heights, right in front of Arnold's Arduous Ascent. We used a light static line to lower some boats down over Biceps. Others walked the rest down the north end of Carderock.

It took us only about 30 minutes to get 2 boats blown up and all the gear down to the water.

### The crossing begins!

There is a natural trail up the middle of Vaso Island - it's a sometimes swampy dell that lines up with the walk down. It makes it pretty easy to find your way across. That dell ends just upstream of Knubble Wall.



# Getting Ready to Climb

Where to climb? There are so many walls to choose from! Setting up is also a bit more challenging than at neighboring Carderock. Knubble Face and Salad Bar can usually be belayed from the bottom as long as there have been enough dry days to make sure the rocks are not slippery. There are walkdowns at the cut-through and just north of Salad Wall. There is also a walkdown just south of Knubble Face, but it is steep enough that a rope is a good idea - but you will also need to share this gully with poison ivy most times of the year. The other two walkdowns are easier. It's usually a good idea to belay Thorn Wall from the top, but since it really hadn't rained in weeks, the water was low enough to belay Thorn Wall from the bottom (just barely).


